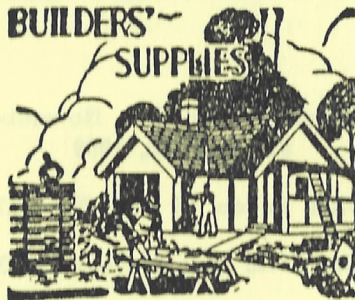

"THE MAID OF THE MOUNTAINS"

The story opens in the bandits' stockade in the mountains. Baldassarre, the chief, has decided that the gang must be disbanded as it is now too dangerous to continue to operate, particularly as they have in their midst "Teresa," the maid. Angela, the Governor's daughter, and her companion, Vittoria, lose their way in fog and stumble on the hiding place. Baldassarre thinks himself in love with Angela and, from her, learns that a new Governor arrives that day, replacing her father for his inability to capture the bandits.

When Teresa is captured, Baldassarre decides to waylay the new Governor and his party and assume their identities to effect her rescue, but, when he arrives in Santo, Baldassarre becomes so infatuated with Angela that he refuses to leave. In a fit of jealousy Teresa denounces them, and the old Governor is able to make a simple capture and imprison them on Devils Island, and so regain favour with the people.

The bandits are not unduly disturbed by their incarceration and, with due audacity, several escape by swimming to the mainland. The officer in charge of the prison, because of his discontent with the administration, allows the rest to escape, and Teresa and Baldassarre are eventually reunited.

Many comedy scenes are enacted by Tonio and Vittoria, his wife, whom he had hoodwinked into thinking he was drowned when rescuing a fellow creature, and joined the bandits. However, because of her wealth, he thought it was better to return to his love-nest and put up with his wife.

Remarkable History of
"THE MAID OF THE MOUNTAINS"

When the late George Edwardes was first approached by the author, Frederick Lonsdale, to put on "The Maid," and after Mr. Edwardes had read the play, he commented: "It's not a bad story, but I don't like romance with robbers." However, he agreed to make a contract if Mr. Lonsdale supplied the first act within six weeks. Mr. Lonsdale made all the action take place in a hut, through which there was no glimpse of the mountains. The setting had to be altered.

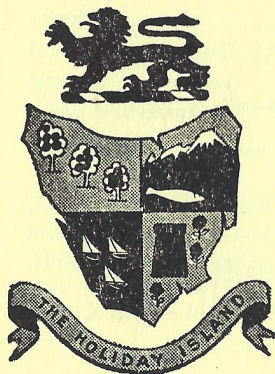
The arrangements for the music were made in a strange way. Mr. Fraser-Simpson, the composer, then practically unknown, was introduced and was given a contract which stipulated that in the event of his music not being used he would be paid £1000. He bought a castle with the money that eventually came to him.

On the first night of the show, the author was very disappointed with the work and offered to sell his interest for £500, but was strongly advised not to dispose of it, and the huge success of "The Maid" since then is well-known.

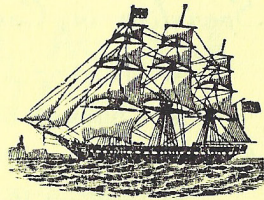
THE SAVOYARDS introduced the first full-scale musicals to this district in 1961, and "The Maid" is the 15th production.

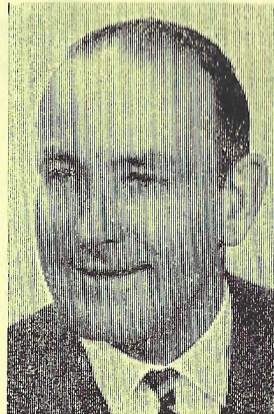
